

Data protection information for applicants

Purpose of the data processing

The purpose of the data processing is the initiation of employment relationships on the basis of Art. 88 Para. 1, Art. 6 Para. 1 b) EU- GDPR, § 26 BDSG. Data is not passed on to other companies.

Recipient categories

Applicants' data will not be passed on to third parties. Since we use various service companies committed to secrecy and data protection for our information technology, access to personal data in this context cannot be excluded. Categories of recipients outside the business and personnel management are service providers for hosting and support. Data is only passed on to public authorities in the event of overriding legal provisions. Data is not transferred to third countries.

Duration of data storage and deletion

Your data will be stored for the duration of the application process; after a decision has been made on your application or after the position has been awarded, the data will be stored for 6 months; in the case of unsolicited applications or if you agree to allow the data to be stored for longer for possible future employment, for a maximum of two years.

Your right to information, rectification, deletion, object and data portability

You may exercise your right to information, rectification and deletion of data at any time. Simply contact us using one of the methods described above. Should you require data to be deleted, which we are still legally obligated to retain, access to your data will be restricted (blocked). The same applies to an appeal. You may exercise your right to data portability if both we and the recipient have the technical means to do so.

Right of appeal

You have the option at any time to file an appeal with a data protection supervisory authority.

Obligation to provide

Without correct information from you, it is not possible to carry out the application process. This may mean that your application cannot be considered in an ongoing process.
